



Integration

for non-French-speaking or non-English speaking pupils
(new pupil or change of section)

- **Integration in preschool**

- It is recommended, at an early age, to discover one language after another.
- We recommend the French section for the first year for non-Francophone families.

- **Integration in cycle 2**

- No integration in 1st year of primary school (CP) for the child has to learn to read in a language he/she knows well.
- French section : possible in 2nd or 3rd year (CE1 or CE2) (based on school records, a meeting with the family and a possible test of level in the mother tongue).
- Bilingual section : possible in 2nd or 3rd year (CE1 or CE2) (based on school records, a meeting with the family and a possible test of level in French or in English).

- **Integration in cycle 3**

- French section : possible, based on the school records.
- French section with reinforced English: possible, based on the school records and passing of an English test.
- International section: based on the school records and passing of an English and/or French test.
